Mutton Bustin' Rules & Regulations

ONLY A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN MAY REGISTER A CHILD IN THE MUTTON BUSTIN' EVENT. NO EXCEPTIONS.

The entry fee for Mutton Bustin' is \$20.00.

- 1) The first 50 qualified & registered contestants will be in the event.
- 2) Release forms & waivers must be signed by a parent or guardian to participate in the event. Allow yourself time to get registered. Failure to check-in before the rodeo performance and return the signed waiver will result in forfeiting your child's participation and entry fee.
- Children must be between 3-10 years of age and <u>may not exceed 55</u>
 <u>Ibs</u> (this is for the safety of the animal) <u>NO EXCEPTIONS.</u>
- Contestants must wear long pants, boots or sturdy shoes (no flip flops or sandals). No spurs. Long sleeve shirts & pants are <u>highly</u> <u>recommended</u>.
- 5) Protective helmets will be required (for the safety of the child). Please bring your own fitted bicycle / hockey style helmet. We will have some on hand if you do not have one. NO RACING style helmets with a point in front.
- 6) 1 parent is admitted in the pits with each contestant registration. No food or drinks allowed. Adults who enter the pits should also wear sturdy shoes and are expected to follow instruction from the volunteers and wranglers.
- 7) Check in at the stage when you arrive at the grandstand.
- 8) There will be a NCCFC staff member to assist and direct each contestant. Listen to the staff / announcer for all instructions.

- 9) At the completion of the ride, volunteers will be on hand to quickly pick up the rider, and assist them from the arena. It is important that things move along quickly.
- 10) **SCORING PROCEDURES** Riders must stay on 6 seconds to receive a score. Decisions of the judges are final. No re-rides will be given.
- 11) Choice of animal is not allowed.
- 12) Contestant is to grasp with both hands during the ride. No extra points are given for one hand rides.
- 13) No spurs, ropes or riggings will be allowed.
- 14) Prizes will be awarded as follows: The top scorer will receive a buckle..
- 15) The Event Director and Judge's decisions are final for any questions that may arise regarding the event.

Event officials' decisions are final. The committee reserves the right to make changes to these rules as deemed necessary.
